Camden Town Council Meeting February 16, 2017 Camden-Jackson Twp. Library, Reading Room

Following the Pledge of Allegiance, Mr. Robison called the regular meeting of the Camden Town Council to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Members Brent Deel, Mark Schock, Andy Robison, Deputy-Clerk Treasurer Lynette Martin, Attorney Anne Briggs and seven guests.

Motion to approve the minutes from the January 19th Organizational Meeting was made by Mr. Schock, seconded by Mr. Deel. Motion to approve the minutes from the January 19th Regular Meeting was made by Mr. Deel, seconded by Mr. Robison. After a review of the claims, Mr. Deel made the motion to approve the February Docket & Allowance Docket which was seconded by Mr. Schock and passed.

Pete Wagoner gave a brief update on the C-FRCC project. Mr. Robison announced the resignation of Scott Billings on the Area Plan Commission and asked for suggestions for his replacement. Vanessa McKinney and Ross Larimore were both mentioned.

Department Reports

Utility/Street Superintendent, Jerry Snavely, gave an update on switching out the lights to LED lights in the community building. He reported that a blower was lost at the waste water plant and he will look for a replacement.

Mr. Deel made a motion to reject the two bid proposals presented at the January meeting— Midwest Paving and Central Paving. Mr. Schock seconded the motion and it passed. Mr. Schock made a motion to re-bid the work as two projects—paving and cement. Motion was seconded by Mr. Deel and motion passed. Ken Smith was asked to prepare the bids and make the necessary contacts. Bids will be accepted at the March meeting.

Mr. Smith addressed the ditch project south of town. Camden is competing against four other communities for the grant and three grants will be awarded. He requested pictures from the town to help show the need for the project. He will be video-taping the storm sewer next week. As for ideas for growth on the east side of the railroad, Mr. Smith said that information would come at a later date.

The Marshal's Report was read aloud by Mr. Dunning. Mr. Dunning also presented the Council with a revised Policy and Procedure Manual for the Marshal for their review. There was some discussion about a reserve program.

Mr. Schock made a motion to approve the Fire Protection Contract with Jackson Township. It was seconded by Mr. Deel and motion passed. Mr. Deel made a motion to sign the license agreement for Key Fund seconded by Mr. Schock. Motion passed.

In Other Matters:

- Mr. and Mrs. Gary Linn appeared before the Council to request a second adjustment as the result of a water leak outside their house which was repaired on February 8, 2017. Mr. Deel made a motion to allow the Linn's the second adjustment in their March bill and Mr. Schock seconded the motion. Motion passed.
- 2. Mr. Dunning indicated that he intended to have a meeting with Philip Wolf about the Ordinance violation (noise) occurring at his garage (466 E Cumberland).
- 3. There was discussion on the new Golf Cart Ordinance which Anne Briggs is to finalize.
- 4. The Council approved the installation of interior door locks and replacing a bi-fold door with a regular door at the med center.

Old Business:

The Wildcat Creek Wildlife Center will present a program at the community building on March 22nd at 6:30 p.m. This program is the "special program unique to the community", a requirement of the Housing Rehab Grant. The public is invited.

Mr. Robison asked for a motion for Vanessa McKinney to continue as the town's representative on the library board. Mr. Schock made the motion with a second from Mr. Deel. Motion passed.

Misc.

Create Hair Studio will open from 9-4 on Saturday, February 25th. They will do \$10.00 haircuts for Men and Women and \$5.00 cuts for children. It will be a first come first served basis. 100% of proceeds will be donated to the families of Liberty German and Abigail Williams.
