

Camden Town Council
Public Meeting
April 28, 2015

The properly called and advertized public meeting of the Camden Town Council was called to order at 4:45pm at the Camden Town Office by Council President Jeff Sieber. Present were Council Members Kandance Funk and Richard Fite, and Clerk-Treasurer Pat Casserly.

1. Ms. Funk made the motion to hire Dan Smith to work full time as the Utility Assistant. Motion was seconded by Mr. Fite and passed. Mr. Sieber suggested he call Mr. Smith to inform him of the Council's decision and see if he is available to start work on Monday, May 4th. Mr. Sieber will also call Mr. Snavelly and inform him of the selection.
2. Cost to repair the door at the medical center, which was broken when an angry citizen pushed it open so hard it the stone veneer and broke the glass, is \$374.31. This amount is less than the property insurance deductible. Ms. Funk moved pay the bill as presented and also ask Mrs. Briggs to write the citizen a letter asking for payment. Motion seconded by Mr. Fite and passed.
3. An update *Fair Housing Ordinance, Number 2015-2*, was presented for approval. This ordinance is required as part of the documentation for Federal grants. The original ordinance passed in 2004 did not contain language now required. Motion to approve *General Ordinance 2015-2, Repealing and Replacing Fair Housing Ordinance 2004-9* was made by Ms. Funk, seconded by Mr. Fite and passed.
4. *Ordinance 2014-3 2015 Salary Ordinance, Amended*, was presented and the section applying to the Utility Assistant salary was read aloud. The changes in this section reflected the changes set by the Council at their April 9th public meeting. Mr. Fite moved to accept the ordinance as presented, seconded by Ms. Funk and passed.

The meeting adjourned at 4:53.
