

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-8
ESTABLISHING USER FEES FOR THE
DEPARTMENT OF STORM WATER MANAGEMENT
FOR THE TOWN OF CAMDEN, INDIANA

WHEREAS THE Town of Camden, Carroll County, Indiana has heretofore constructed and has in operation a storm water collecting system for the purpose of collecting and managing storm water run off, and,

WHEREAS, storm water and surface water control and management are important functions for said Town of Camden, and,

WHEREAS, said Town has caused to be formed a Storm Water Management District and has appointed a Board of Directors to administer and manage said District, and,

WHEREAS Indiana Code 8-115-5-2 provides that said Board, after approval by the Town Council of said Town may assess and collect user fees from all the property in the Storm Water District, and

WHEREAS, the cost of collecting and managing storm water are not presently being recovered from the properties generating that storm water runoff and/or by the properties served by that reason, and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council and the Storm Water Management District Directors find that a storm water fee should be enacted to for the costs of collecting and managing storm water pursuant to the provisions of said IC 8-1.5-5, which storm water fee should be charged, collected and administered by the Town,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Camden, Carroll County, Indiana, as follows:

- 1). There is hereby established a monthly storm water utility fee to be charged to all owners of real estate within the corporate limits of said Town of Camden, Indiana, for the use of and services provided by the storm water utility of said Town.
- 2) For residential real estate, the monthly storm water utility fee shall be a flat consumer charge of Three Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$3.50) per month.
- 3). For non-residential real state, the monthly storm water utility fee shall be a customer charge of Three Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$3.50) per month.
- 4). If the monthly storm water utility fee is not paid by the due date stated on the bill, a

late charge of ten percent (10)) will be assessed, together with costs of collection, if any, including reasonable attorney fees.

5). The monthly water utility fee as set out herein shall become effective and payable beginning with the September 1st, 2017 billing month.

6) This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any publication and notice as required by, law.


