

CAMDEN TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES
TOWN OF CAMDEN INDIANA
February 9, 2022

The Camden Town Council met in a legally advertised meeting on Wednesday, February 9, 2022 at 7:00 PM in the Camden Library Reading Room.

Those present were, President: Brent Deel, Mark Schock and Andrew Robison, Clerk Treasurer Jeff Sieber, Utility Superintendent Jerry Snavelly, Marshal Jill Hammond and 4 guests.

Mr. Deel lead the group in the Pledge of Allegiance after opening the regular stated meeting.

A motion was made by Mr. Robison and a second from Mr. Schock to approve the minutes of the January meeting as well as all Dockets and reports submitted.

Utility Superintendant Jerry Snavelly reported that meter reads should be done next week, however, due to weather, estimates may need to be done for this month. He will wait and see how much snow melt we have before then.

He reported that the new heaters have been ordered and are due in at any time.

Snavelly said that street cleaning after the recent snow storm went well. Council members commended him and Codey on the fine job that was done. They stated they had received several compliments on how well the snow was handled.

Mr. Snavelly also stated he would be getting in touch with Duke Energy to reach out to the Engineer regarding the LED changeover for the red flashing light.

Marshal Jill Hammond submitted her report as attached. She also stated that she has a few Ordinance violation letters that are being ignored and she will be sending out second notices and then violations will be sent to the courts for Attorney Briggs to follow thru with. She also stated that she will soon begin sending golf cart permit renewal letters to those residents with carts as their expiration dates approach.

Clerk Treasurer, Jeff Sieber reported that the new Credit Card Company that he was originally going with has been notified to cancel the contract due to changes they wanted to make. He stated the town will be going thru a different company and that the change would be up and running by the first of the month and be in operation for the next round of bill paying. This company will give the customer more options in ways of paying their bill on line.

Clerk Sieber presented the second installment for the Wastewater Planning Grant for approval and council signature.

Joe O'Donnell from a Partnership for a Drug Free Carroll County presented the council with a memo from the Governor stating that he would like to see Narcan boxes in public areas of each county and town. The county organization is requesting approval to place a box somewhere on a town owned property. After questioning O'Donnell regarding the liability to the town and who would be responsible for the meds, the council voted by a motion by Mr. Schock, seconded by Mr. Robison to allow a box be placed on the Med Center if the Center employees were ok with the placement.

Ken Smith asked the council for permission to continue with the grant process for the relocation of the Hunt Drain. They stated he had complete approval to continue as long as he worked within the perimeters of the grant. Mr. Smith was also given blanketed permission to pursue any future grants and monies that would benefit the town.

Mr. Schock asked Mr. Smith if he knew of any grants available that would help Mr. Mylet with the work he is doing on the old Select Seed building. He stated he would have to look into it and see what there may be.

The Town Office will be closed on February 21, in observance of President's Day.

Next meeting will March 9, 2022.

Mr. Robison made a motion, seconded by Mr. Schock to adjourn at 7:30.

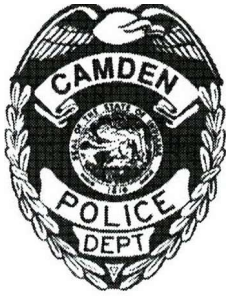
