

CAMDEN TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES
TOWN OF CAMDEN INDIANA
MAY 10, 2023

The Camden Town Council met in a legally advertised meeting on Wednesday, May 10, 2023 at 7:00 PM in the Library Reading Room.

Those present were, President Brent Deel, Andy Robison, Clerk Treasurer Jeff Sieber, Marshal Jill Hammond, Utility Superintendent Jerry Snavelly and 3 guests.

Mr. Deel lead the group in the Pledge of Allegiance after opening the meeting.

A motion was made by Mr. Robison and a second from Mr. Deel to approve the minutes of the April meeting as well as all Dockets and reports submitted.

Utility Superintendent, Jerry Snavelly stated he has met with the gentleman from Reith Riley regarding the 218 construction. He stated that Codey has had the mosquito sprayer calibrated and ready for the season.

Snavelly said he has gotten cost quotes on cement delivery and that 70 foot of sidewalk can be done per load. delivery prices range from free for a truck load to \$80 for smaller amounts. The council said that the work needs to be started and the sidewalk by Mike Everetts and where the combine broke it needs to be done in the first round. Snavelly said that walk just south of the flasher light needs to be looked in to and some trees removed in that area. He also said the tree in front of Foreman's needs removed.

Marshal Jill Hammond gave her report as attached. She also said that Ordinance violation letters have started going out and she will continue with those this week.

Clerk Treasurer, Jeff Sieber said that Trash company bids will be due before the next meeting and that the bids will be opened in June. He also stated that he has been notified that the 4 year audit is due and will be conducted yet this summer by SBOA.

Council members signed the parade route request and approved the map of the route.

Deel stated that all of the street lights have been replaced with LED lights and that they seem to be putting off an efficient amount of light.


Town Offices will be closed May 29, for Memorial Day and that the Fish Fry and Parade are June 3.

Next meeting will be held June 14, 2023.

Mr. Robison made a motion, seconded by Mr. Deel to adjourn at 7:40 PM.
